	" the good deposit entrusted to you" (2 Tim. 1:13-14).	
•	warfare is ultimately a battle over truth. Satan's original question was, "Did God	
	actually say?" (Gen. 3:1). Our strategy is to take every thought captive as we destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God (2 Cor. 10:4-5).
